













This infrastructurally rich school is comprised of three Blocks namely the Senior Wing, the MCM Block and the N. D. Grover Block.



Admission Procedure (Session 2026-27)

Eligibility

Age eligibility (As per New Education Policy 1st April,2026 of the academic session for which admission is sought)

NUR	3 to 4 years
LKG	4 to 5 years
UKG	5 to 6 years
StdI	6 to 7 years
StdII	7 to 8 years

Registration

- 1. The form available on the School website should be duly filled and submitted with the non-refundable, non-transferable registration fee within 7 days from the date of issue of the form or within the stipulated time.
- 2.A copy of birth certificate must be attached with the registration form.
- 3.Students who have attended other schools need to submit a photocopy of the report card of the previous year from the previous school attended along with the transfer certificate

NOTE: THE REGISTRATION DOES NOT IN ANY WAY GUARANTEE ADMISSION

Interaction, Counselling & Personality Assessment

- 1.The children who have been registered are required to appear for a Personality Assessement (for class III onwards), conducted by the School for different levels.
- 2.The assessment will cover English, Hindi, Mathematics and/or any other subject which may be considered necessary
- 3. The selection of the candidates will depend upon the child's performance in the Counseling Cum Personality Assessment and availability of seats in the respective classes.
- 4. Assessment of the child for admission is also based on the following factors:
 - i. Academic readiness and motivation.
 - ii. Social and emotional development.
 - iii. Ability of the school to serve the needs of the child.
 - iv. The date of the result of the Assessment and the last date for the submission of fee will be specified at the time of the Assessment/Interview.
 - v. Based on the personality assessment and other criteria, the School reserves the right to admit any student who is found eligible for admission or decline admission without assigning any reason.

The Principal's/Management's decision will be final in matters concerning admission.

Fee Payment Guidelines

- Payment of fees shall be accepted using Netbanking, online transfer, by Debit/Credit/ ATM card or UPI payment. No cash transaction is allowed.
- To save time and avoid inconvenience it is preferable that fee be deposited quarterly/half-yearly/ annually in advance.
- 3) Fees will be accepted as per the norms given below:
 - a) Fee Counter Timing: Monday to Friday, 8:00 am to 12:00 noon (Except on Bank
 - & Gazetted Holidays)
 - b) Fee can be deposited from 1st to 20th of every month without fine.
 - c) From 20th to 25th with a fine of Rs. 50/-
 - d) From 25th to 30th/31st fee counter will remain closed.
- 4)If fee is not deposited for two consecutive months, the name of the student shall be struck off the Rolls of Admission Register, which may be considered by the competent authorities with a fine of Rs. 500/-

Note: Track Suit/House Uniform may be introduced as per norms of DAV Management

- NB: 1.In Case a Student is not in proper school uniform, not neatly dressed or not in time to school, he/she will not be allowed to enter the school premises.
 - 2. Girls are strictly prohibited from applying mehndi, nail polish and hair colour.
 - 3.All boys should come to school with a neat presentable haircut. They must desist from sporting a trendy haircut and hairstyle.

Transport

- 1.All the students of the School Bus are expected to be on the right side of their bus stops at least five minutes prior to the arrival time of the bus.
- Unauthorized travelling by students in school buses is not permitted. Such students are liable to fines for this wrongdoing and will be charged a month's bus fee.
- No student should come near the entry door of the bus until it has come to a complete halt.
- 4. The drivers are authorized to stop buses at the designated stop only, unless otherwise directed by the bus-in-charge for any deviation. The list of stops is prepared keeping in view the convenience and safety of all the riders and is sometimes subject to change.
- 5. When the bus is in motion, the riders must not have any part of their body out of the windows.
- Obejcts of any kind must not be discarded inside or thrown out of the bus.
- Discarding of trash of food either inside or outside the bus is not permitted.

- Shrieking, shouting, or any other kind of unruly behavior is strictly prohibited. Courteous behavior is expected at all times.
- The driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason.
- 10.Parents can track the current location of the bus using GPS Tracking System




